FOR SOME, THERE'S NOTHING MORE ENJOYABLE than sleeping under the stars in a tiny two-man tent and dining on tinned spaghetti warmed in a billy can over an open flame.

But for those of us who find the prospect of a communal ablution block, sand beneath the sheets and over-friendly mosquitoes less than appealing, there are state-of-the-art mobile homes equipped with all the essential creature comforts to rough it in style.

New to the motorhome market is the Trakka Torino, which is more akin to a well-appointed hotel room than a caravan. With room for four seated guests, or two sleeping guests on a comfy double bed, the Trakka Torino also boasts a bathroom with a hot shower (a serious bonus), gas stove, refrigerator, sophisticated power systems for remote camping and many other comfort options such as room heating, solar-charging systems and the latest high definition digital TV and DVD players.

Better still, the vehicle's energy-saving design and excellent fuel economy makes it gentle on the environment – with customer feedback confirming fuel consumption of less than 10 litres per 100 kilometres.

The Trakka Torino has a powerful 2.3-litre direct injection turbo diesel engine and retails from \$90,000.
